AGENDA ITEM 2: Organisation of the Meeting

Purpose

1. To explain the rules of procedure for the conduct of the Meeting and to elect officials.

Background

- 2. The Rules of Procedure of the Waigani Convention apply to the Meeting in accordance with Article 23 of the Convention. Copies may be obtained from www.sprep.org.
- 3. Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure states that at the commencement of the first session of each ordinary meeting, a Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson and a Rapporteur are to be elected from among the representatives of the Contracting Parties by a simple majority vote. At previous meetings, the Secretariat has fulfilled the function of the Rapporteur.
- 4. There are 12 Contracting Parties to the Convention: Australia, Cook Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Fiji, Kiribati, New Zealand, Niue, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Tuvalu, and Vanuatu.
