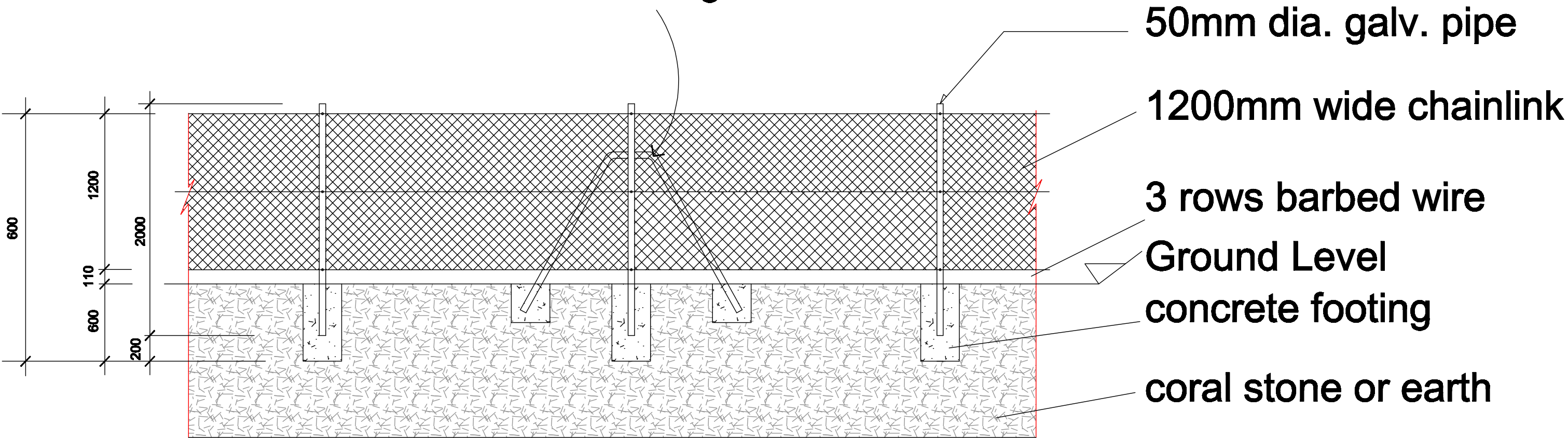

## Gate

Pigs are to be excluded from the reserve through the installation of 670-meter pig-proof fence to be located according to the specifications provided on Mt Talau in Vava'u, Tonga.

The fence will be constructed of chain link mesh with a barbed wire running along the bottom.

Kissing gates should be installed at the entrance and at key locations such as viewpoints where visitors would need to access outside the fenced area. Where viewpoints are constructed the fence should about the viewpoint fence. Kissing gates allow the passage of people but restrict livestock from gaining access.
