



1. Myself and a good friend and colleague, would like to jointly apply for this position. Is this amenable to you and for the tender?

2. Can you please advise on the number of days for the consultancy services advertised to prepare Nauru NCCP that is due Oct 30th, 2019?

Response:

The number of days depends on the tenderer provided the National Climate Change Policy is finalised by 30th June 2020.

3. The Request for Tenders includes a reference to a national roadmap developed in 2005 up to 2025. This is a long time ago. Any climate policy will, or should be, deeply embedded into any long-term roadmaps. Does the scope of the assignment include an evaluation/reflection on this roadmap, and should it be updated based on the climate change policy development? Similar arguments apply to the other legal frameworks.

Response:

This consultancy includes reviewing of all relevant national legislation, policies, strategies, plans and agreements that directly relates to the development of the Climate Change Policy, gaps and overlaps determined from this review will form the basis of Climate Change Policy development. Refer to Term of Reference table 1.

4. Nauru is a small island, and any successful long-term policies and climate (adaptation) "pathways" will be deeply embedded in the local economy and society as a whole. In our experience the decision makers will need to be involved at the right moments. Are the right stakeholders involved to have high-level discussions on the implications of proposed strategies? And can they make decisions? What additional support would they need?

Response:

This consultancy includes national stakeholder consultations, making sure that right stakeholders are involved, taking into account their consolidated views Refer to Term of Reference table 1.

5. Do you have any indication of budget or scope? Specifically "national stakeholder consultation" can take many shapes, where we can focus on several rounds of interviews, focus groups, and workshop(s) (i.e. a shorter country visit), or we can develop an approach that will help develop buy-in of all stakeholders throughout the entire process (which will take more visits), i.e. the Dutch "klimaattafels" approach.

Response

Nauru being a small Island nation, shorter country visit is mandatory with several interviews and workshop, done quickly. In addition, provide your financial and technical proposal including an indicative budget to complete this task.

6. The current Request seems to imply two visits (one for consultations, one for a workshop). Is this correct?

Response

The number visits should not exceed 2 visits to Nauru. The visits should include consultations (face-to-face meeting with individual or target groups) and national stakeholder and workshops.
