Question 1:

Can you provide some indication on the likely scale of inspection required? For example is it over a certain number of river kilometres, or do you anticipate a certain number of days in the field to complete the inspection.

Response:

Inspection is required to the entire river system, implementation of alternative river stabilisation will provided to prioritised area (badly degraded)

Question 2:

Can you please clarify how the consultant can provide a realistic budget estimate for implementation of the interventions when the identification of the interventions (and confirmation through national consultation) is part of the project itself?

Response:

The consultant will have to determine cost effective analysis to the problem areas, these will be prioritised, most prioritised area will be selected for implementation. If that is over the budget, will look at the second viable option to implement.

Question 3:

Will the consultant be required to commit to the budget estimate for implementation even though the interventions may change through the results of tasks 1 to 6 of the project?
